

21-DAY READING PLAN

The Gospel of *John*

Twenty-one days. Twenty-one chapters. One short reading a day to meet the living Jesus in the pages of Scripture.

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." — John 1:1

How to use this *plan*

21 DAYS

We're so glad you've decided to open the Word. The Gospel of John was written for one reason — that you would believe in Jesus and have life in His name.

It has twenty-one chapters, so this plan is beautifully simple: read one chapter a day for twenty-one days. Each day takes only a few minutes, but if you keep showing up, you will not be the same on Day 21.

1

Pick a time and stick to it

Morning coffee, lunch break, or before bed — consistency matters more than length.

2

Read slowly and pray first

Ask the Holy Spirit, "Show me Jesus today," then read the chapter unhurried.

3

Answer the daily reflection

Each day has a key verse and one question. Jot a sentence or pray it back to God.

4

Check the box & keep going

Miss a day? No guilt. Just pick up where you left off and finish the journey.

5**John 5 Do You Want to Be Well?**

Reflect: Is there an area where you have stopped expecting healing? · Key verse: John 5:6

6**John 6 The Bread of Life**

Reflect: How is Jesus your daily sustenance — not just for Sundays? · Key verse: John 6:35

7**John 7 Rivers of Living Water**

Reflect: Ask the Holy Spirit to flow through you to someone today. · Key verse: John 7:38

Reflect: How have you heard the Shepherd's voice this week? · Key verse: John 10:11

11**John 11 Lazarus, Come Forth**

Reflect: What "dead" situation are you asking God to raise to life? · Key verse: John 11:25

12**John 12 Unless a Seed Falls**

Reflect: What is God asking you to surrender so it can bear fruit? · Key verse: John 12:24

DAY
13**John 13 Love One Another**

Reflect: Whose feet can you "wash" with humble love this week? · Key verse: John 13:34

14**John 14 The Way, the Truth, the Life**

Reflect: What worry can you trade for His peace today? · Key verse: John 14:6

Reflect: Rest in this: Jesus prayed for you before you were born. · Key verse: John 17:20

18**John 18 Betrayed, Yet in Control**

Reflect: Where do you need to trust God's plan over your fear? · Key verse: John 18:37

DAY
19**John 19 It Is Finished**

Reflect: Thank Jesus for everything the cross accomplished for you. · Key verse: John 19:30

20**John 20 He Is Risen**

Reflect: How does the resurrection change your today? · Key verse: John 20:29

21**John 21 Do You Love Me?**

Reflect: Jesus asks, "Do you love Me?" How will your life answer? · Key verse: John 21:17
